The successful candidate will be well-organized, energetic, and service oriented with the following qualifications:

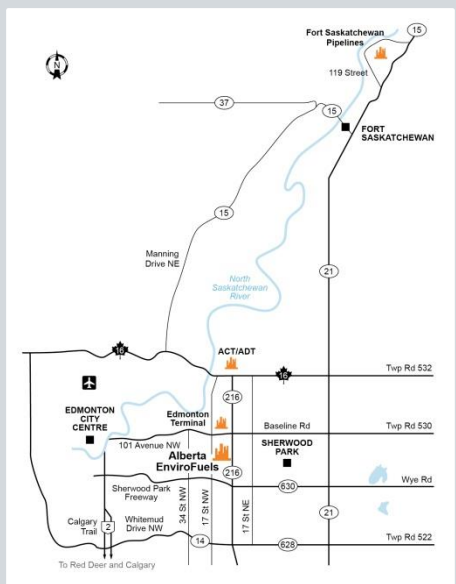
- Utilize the knowledge of Keyera's Health and Safety Management System.
