This is a camp role with a 2 weeks on / 2 weeks off rotation

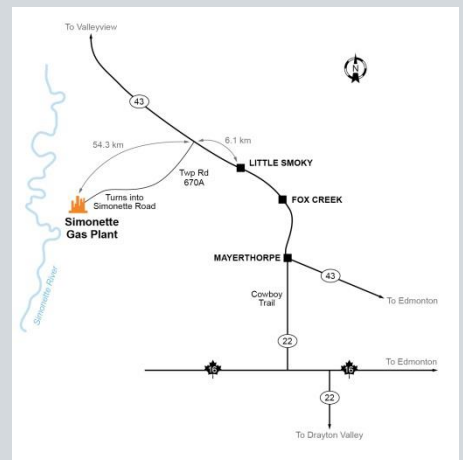
RESPONSIBILITIES
