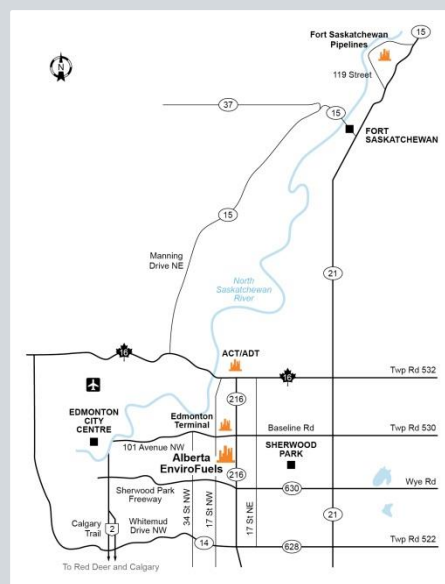
- Participate in design and preparation of engineering drawings for facility operations.
