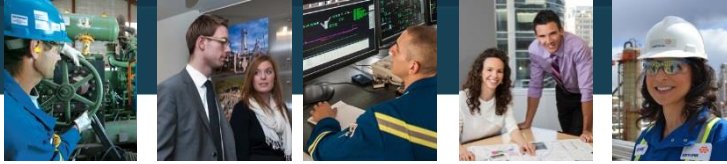

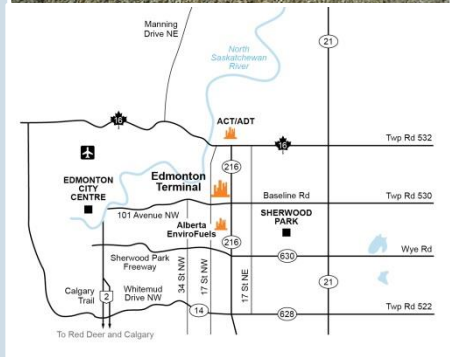
RESPONSIBILITIES:
