This position will be a camp based role with rotation of 7/7.

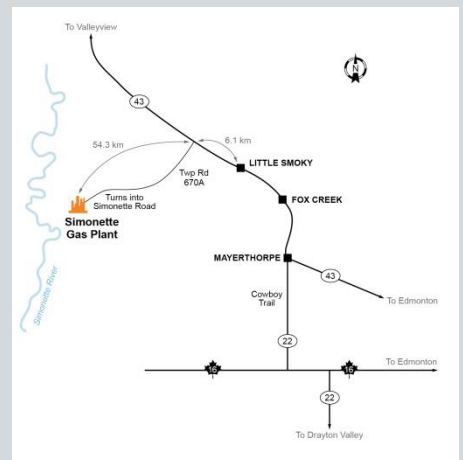
### RESPONSIBILITIES
