RESPONSIBILITIES

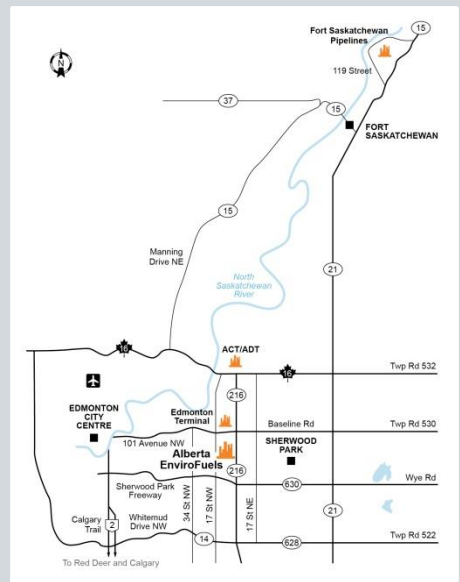
- Conduct predictive, preventative and corrective regular maintenance on all instrumentation and controls equipment.
