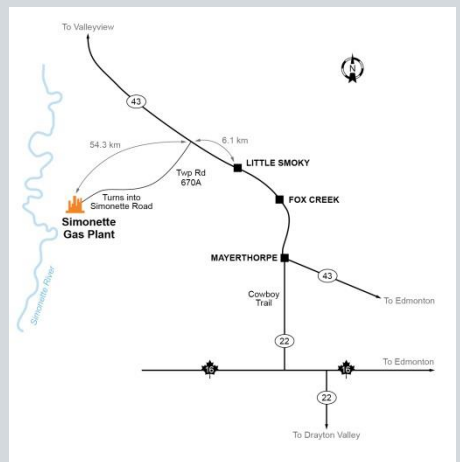
RESPONSIBILITIES
