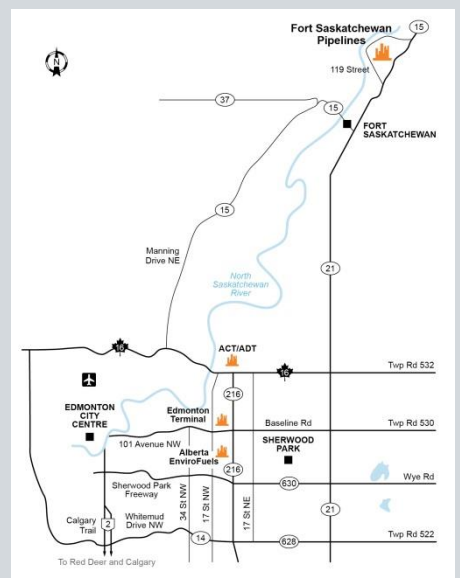
RESPONSIBILITIES

ABOUT THE FACILITY

Keyera's Fort Saskatchewan facilities include an NGL processing plant, storage facilities and four pipelines connecting to the Edmonton Terminal. The NGL processing plant receives NGL feedstock from various sources and splits the NGL mix into saleable products. The storage facilities consist of underground storage caverns and surface storage that holds NGL mix feedstock and specification NGLs. The pipeline system transports NGL mix to the Fort Saskatchewan facilities and saleable specification NGLs from these facilities, as well as other NGL processing and storage facilities in the area, to the Edmonton Terminal for distribution to markets and export rail, truck and pipelines.
