RESPONSIBILITIES

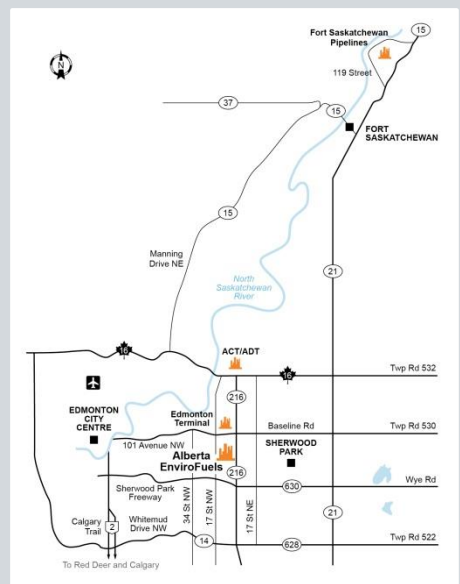
- Provide project management for Capital and OPEX projects from conception to completion.
