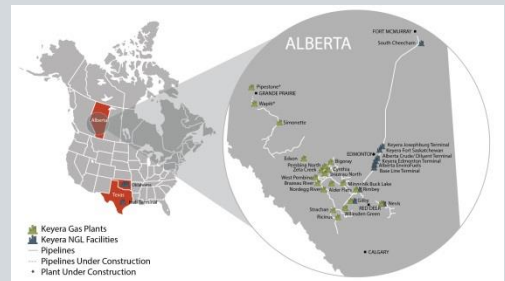
- Review and prepare daily reports that include production weekly volume and monthly budget.
