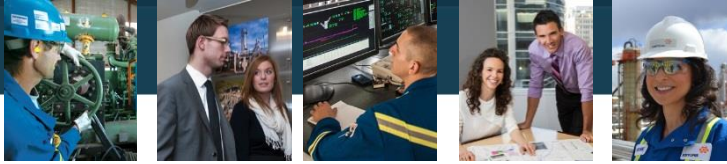

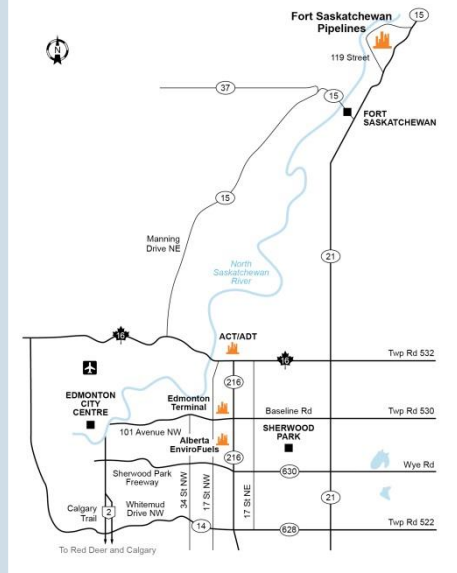
RESPONSIBILITIES
